



Criteria to Nominate a Member for the CPN Kurt Ryback Memorial Service Award

In accordance with our 2005 Strategic Plan (3-B)

Nominations are by current members of the Board of Directors

Eligibility:

1. Current member in good standing of CPN not serving on the Executive Committee

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstration of outstanding, long term contribution to CPN through their participation in committees and/or leadership.
2. Has shown consistent participation in Regional and Statewide meetings.
3. Has taken on an added task(s) and/or responsibility during the current CPN year.
4. Emphasis for consideration will be on the current activities; however, all previous accomplishments should be taken into account.
5. Self nominations are not accepted.

Selection Process

1. Nominations will be accepted until February 13th for the 2014 CPN year.
2. Nominations will be collected by CPN staff and submitted to the members of the Executive Committee for their review and vote.
3. Members of the Executive Committee are the voting body.

Award Process

1. The Immediate Past President will make the presentation to the award recipient(s) prior to the Star Award on during the Black Tie Gala at the Annual Conference. If the recipient(s) is not at the Annual Conference, the President will make the presentation at the next available Regional meeting (or Statewide meeting
